Wellesley Tudor Pole founded the Trust in 1959 as a charity to safeguard and protect Chalice Well and to enable visitors and pilgrims to receive inspiration and refreshment from the waters and the gardens. The aims of the Trust are to:

- preserve in perpetuity Chalice Well, its surroundings and to beautify them for the benefit of the public, so that they may forever access this living sanctuary for pilgrimage and rest
- encourage individual spiritual awareness and growth by offering this place to all people, of all religious and spiritual paths, for pilgrimage, ceremony, quiet contemplation and healing
- facilitate spiritual awareness and harmony in the local and wider community

Chalice Well Events

Our annual programme of events, which includes late night garden openings with music, concerts, retreats and community gatherings and meditations, is available in leaflet form and also at www.chalicewell.org.uk

Our 'Wheel of the Year' events such as the Spring and Autumn Equinoxes, Summer and Winter Solstices, are open to all, regardless of spiritual path or faith, to come to Chalice Well and experience connection and community. On specific dates, we hold midday meditations by the well head. On those dates admission to the gardens is free from 10 am to 12 noon (please enquire at the gatehouse for details of dates on which free entry applies).

In the gardens we are ever-present with nature. Observing the turning wheel of the year allows us to connect and experience the full cycle of nature as it relates to the cycle of human life: First Stirring, Greening, Flowering, Full Bloom, Fruition, Harvest, Resting and Regeneration.

If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Chalice Well Trust asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
